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- With the passage of time, wood, as a natural material, is subject to small alterations in its dimensions and color. The color of natural wood is influenced by its exposure to sunlight, even when it is in an inside space. Consequently, decorative or objects of everyday use which are placed on furniture, should be moved often, especially during the first months of their presence in the space, so as to avoid discoloration of the wood.

- Atmospheric pollution (dust, smudges) can be removed using a dry cotton cloth, without any detergent or solution.

- If water or other liquid is spilled, you should wipe the surface with absorbent paper (kitchen roll) as soon as possible. The process should be repeated two or three times, using a clean piece of absorbent paper, until the wooden surface is completely dry.

- Difficult blemishes, such as red wine, oil etc. should be removed in the same way. If they go unnoticed and remain for several hours on the wooden surface, initially you should wipe only the blemish with absorbent paper and then the whole surface with a damp cotton cloth. If necessary you can repeat the process until the surface is completely dry. If the blemish does not disappear you should contact the repair department of our company.
